MAGIC Go-Live Date Announcement

In the September 2013 Special Edition of the *MAGIC Message*, the project team outlined its reevaluation of the project schedule and the need to reset the target Go-Live dates for MAGIC Phases I and II. During the past several weeks, State and vendor project leadership have worked together to update the project work plan and set new Go-Live dates for both project phases.

The new schedule for MAGIC Go-Live is:

Phase	Go-Live Date	Modules
Phase I	July 1, 2014	Finance, Procurement, Grants Management, and related Business Analytics (i.e. data warehouse functionality)
Phase II	January 1, 2015	Human Resources (HR), Payroll, Enterprise Learning, and related Business Analytics

Dates for submission of interface files by agencies for testing will be revised based on the updated project schedule and will be communicated to agencies as soon as they are finalized. The project team is also updating testing, training, and SuperUser schedules and will provide that information to everyone affected.

One portion of the schedule that does not change is data collection via MRTL tasks. It is critical to the ongoing configuration and testing of MAGIC that each agency continue to complete and submit MRTL tasks by the established deadlines.

Thank you for your continued support of MAGIC. We remain confident that the resulting system will positively impact the administrative functions of State agencies and will be an asset for all State employees.
